Indiana Republican Party Chair **Randy Head** has scheduled a [district caucus](#) for Wednesday, September 4 to fill the vacancy in Senate District 48 created by Sen. **Mark Messmer's** resignation. Messmer is the Republican nominee for U.S. Congress in Indiana's 8th District.

Former Clark County Sheriff **Jamey Noel** pleaded guilty to 27 of 31 counts in a massive [public corruption](#) case. He must pay more than \$3.1 million in restitution and faces up to 12 years in prison.

Indiana's Judicial Nominating Commission appointed Supreme Court Chief Justice **Loretta Rush** to a [third](#) five-year term prior to her facing a retention vote this November.

Robert F. Kennedy, Jr. will stay on Indiana's [ballot](#) despite ending his presidential candidacy last week.

Despite being open to the public fewer days than last year, the **Indiana State Fair** saw a rise in overall [attendance](#) this year.
