Braun Announces Year-One Agenda, First Cabinet Picks

Gov.-Elect **Mike Braun** issued a detailed outline of his first-year <u>policy agenda</u>. No surprise that it comports to his campaign promises.

And he's made his first cabinet picks.

Braun's "Freedom and Opportunity Agenda" focuses on property tax relief, structural reform of state government and operating efficiencies, economic development, public health, and quality of life issues such as public safety, energy, and water quality.

Braun's transition team also announced that **Lisa Hershman** will serve as his secretary of management and budget and former State Rep. **Matt Ubelhor** will be secretary of transportation and infrastructure.

Hershman is the former chief management officer for the U.S. Department of Defense in the first Trump Administration, as well as having a significant private-sector career.

Ubelhor is a long-time coal industry executive. He represented House District 62 from 2010-2015, resigning public office to focus on his professional responsibilities at Peabody Energy.

Both served on Braun's transition team. We expect more cabinet picks to be announced in the coming days.

Indiana Republican Party Chairman **Randy Head** has <u>resigned</u> his post after five months, citing the demands of his other job as a lobbyist. Vice Chair **Erin Lucas** will assume the role of interim chairwoman until the state committee elects a new chair.

Democrats declined to seek a <u>recount</u> in the close House District 25 race between incumbent Rep. **Becky Cash** (R-Zionsville) and **Tiffany Stoner**.
